IHRA is the leading organisation in promoting evidence based harm reduction policies and practices on a global basis for all psychoactive substances (including illicit drugs, tobacco and alcohol).

IHRA exists to reduce the negative impacts of drug and alcohol use for individuals, communities and society.

Our strength comes from our diverse and global membership base, which is growing each year. Members and beneficiaries include policy makers, drug users, health professionals, police, educators, researchers, and communities throughout the world.

IHRA supports the engagement of people and communities affected by drugs and alcohol, and works to promote the human rights of affected populations and counter their marginalisation and stigmatisation.

We work with local, national, regional and international organisations on public health campaigns and advocacy work, knowledge exchange, network communication and the promotion of best practice. The annual "Harm Reduction 2009: IHRA's 20th International Conference" (attended by over 1,200 delegates from all over the world) provides education, training, dialogue and debate about harm reduction responses to drug related issues.
